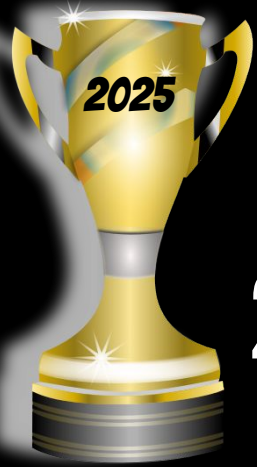

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

HS COPY EDITING

Just a quick reminder of the relatively new UIL Copy Editing scoring change:

- Last year, on Part II, UIL has doubled the value of everything so that decimal scores have been eliminated.
- Each correction on Part II is now worth 1 point, for a total of 4 pts. per sentence.
- The student's final score is a total of Part 1 and Part 2, with a perfect score being 35 (15 pts. on Part 1 + 20 pts on Part 2).

HS SCIENCE - PHYSICS SECTION

From the UIL website:

- **Physics Questions P1 – P3 will be from the reading material.**
- **This year that is the book "Radioactivity" by Marjorie Malley.**
- **Questions for the Invitational A test will come from chapters 1-2, and questions for the Invitational B test will come from chapters 3-4.**
- **For the District test, I will choose questions from chapters 5-6.**
- **Questions for the Regional test will come from chapters 7-8, and questions for the State test will come from chapters 9-10-11.**

From the VCM Physics Test Writer (in response):

Schedule for the Book Questions on the Physics section of the VCM Science Tests:

- VCM Meets #1 and #2 - book questions will be from chapters 1, 2, and 3.
- VCM Meet #3 - book questions will be from chapters 3-4.
- VCM Meet #4 - book questions will be from chapters 5-6 (This will prepare your students for the UIL District Meet, see above)
- VCM Meet #5 (The RQ Meet) - book questions will be from chapters 7-8. (This will prepare your students for the UIL Region Meet, see above)
- VCM Meet #6 (The SQ Meet) - book questions will be from chapters 9-11. (This will prepare your students for the UIL State Meet, see above)

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

HS CURRENT EVENTS

Just a quick reminder of the relatively new UIL Current Events scoring change:

Each correct answer is now worth **2 points**, making **80** the maximum score on a Current Events Test

Additionally, with each correct answer being worth **2 points**, all posted scores must be an **even** number.

Here are the dates that UIL has posted that each UIL Current Event Test will cover:

- Inv. A — August 1st - December 1st
- Inv. B — September - January 1st
- District — October 1st - March 1st
- Region — November 1st - April 1st
- State — January 1st - May 1st

In keeping with the UIL dates, here are the time frames each VCM Current Events Test will utilize:

- Meet # 1 - August 1st - September 25th
- Meet # 2 - August 1st - November 2nd
- Meet # 3 - August 1st - January 1st
- Meet # 4 - October 1st - March 1st (in final preparation for UIL District)
- Meet # 5 RQ -- November 1st - April 1st (in final preparation for UIL Region)
- Meet # 6 SQ - January 1st - May 1st (in final preparation for UIL State)
